Phonics

This week, we will focus on the phonics sounds ea (as in tea), oi (as in spoil) and a-e (as in cake).

Ideas for learning:

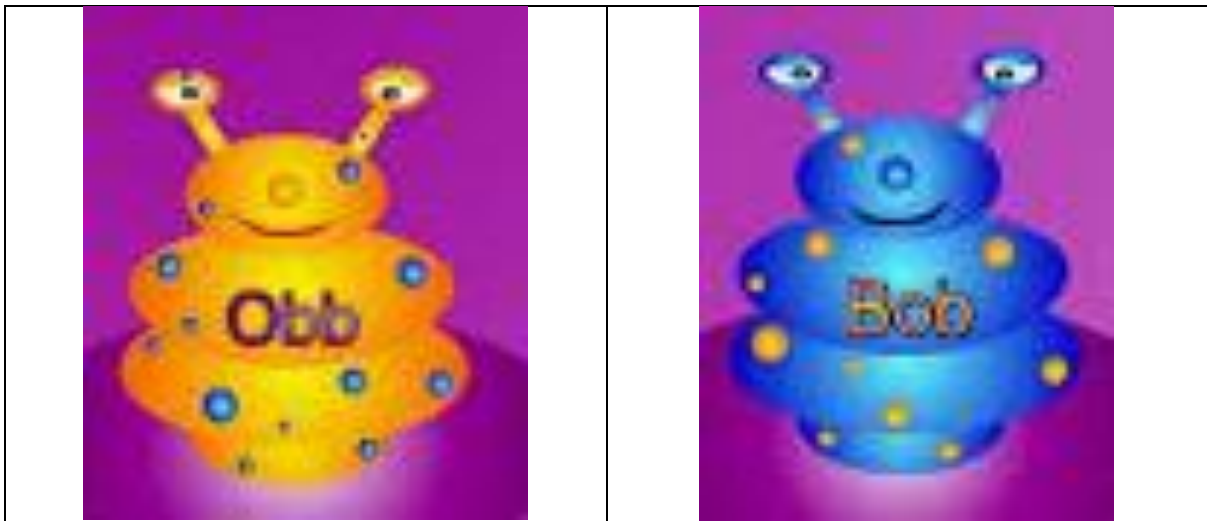
Flash cards - Make and show children flash cards for ea, oi and a-e. Flash through them until children can read these at speed. Why not mix them up with some of the other sounds that they are confident with and see if they can spot the newer sounds.

Read and write words with the new sounds. Here is a list of ideas, can you think of any others?

tea, clean, dream, seat, scream, screaming, real, please, join, coin, choice, voice, noise, date, name, cake, make, same, late

Choose a word, put it into a sentence and write. Remember your capital letter, finger spaces, Fred fingers, red words and full stop.

Obb and Bob – Play Obb and Bob with the attached words. Remember to feed Bob the real words and Obb the nonsense words. When you have done, can you think of any other words to make and feed them? If you don't have access to a printer, why not write and make your own cards.
