Here is our school procedure for reporting test results.

- Between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Mon to Fri (term time) ring the school office on 01226 722011
- Out of school hours – evenings and weekends we ask that you email the test result through to our new email address **covidresultRSJB@smat.org.uk**. This will be monitored periodically on an evening and at the weekend. **Please do not use our normal email addresses to report test results.**

This week our staff have taken part in Google Classroom training which will be our way of remote teaching if class bubbles have to close for any reason. We will be sharing login details with you next week and children will have a go at using this in school. Teachers may also set some short homework tasks on there to get children used to the system if we need to use it due to a closure. Our Year 5 children have already had a practise at using it in the ICT suite with Mr. White.

Also, a big thank you this week to Ms. Steele, Mrs. Levitt and Miss. Openshaw for hosting our parent workshop on Zoom for Early Reading this week. We hope that the parents who took part will have gained some helpful tips on how to support your child with those vital early reading skills. We plan on hosting lots more online meetings through the year so watch this space.
