Please do not wait by doors for other families after collecting your own child/children. We are keeping bubbles separate in school so a swift exit off school grounds really is especially important in keeping us as safe as possible. Please remember that if you need a chat with your child's class teacher a phone call really is the best form of contact. Also, please can you collect any bikes or scooters from the shelter as you pass on your way to pick up your child. This avoids any parents and children crossing in our one-way system. Thank you for your support with this.

We had hoped that our new entry and exit procedures would be only a temporary measure, however it appears that they will be here to stay for a significant length of time. With that in mind we have looked to have a permanent path to replace the black sheeting across the Reception Class outside area. Rest assured that plans are in place and work will begin as soon as possible.

Covid test Results

We want to make the process for reporting Covid test results as easy as possible. Here is our school procedure for reporting test results which was outlined on the letter sent home on Wednesday.

- Between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Mon to Fri (term time) ring the school office on 01226 722011
- Out of school hours – evenings and weekends we ask that you email the test result through to our new email address **covidresultRSJB@smat.org.uk**. This will be monitored periodically on an evening and at the weekend. **Please do not use our normal email addresses to report test results.**

Following a positive test result, school will always take advice from the Department for Education to see the next steps and this may result in the closure of a year group (bubble) with immediate effect. If the decision is made to close a bubble when children are not in school, a text message will be sent to tell you of the decision. If the children are in school when the decision is made, then a text message will be sent to come and collect your child. Siblings should remain in school unless the child/household member starts to display symptoms.

I hope you all have a safe weekend and manage to spend as much time as possible outdoors. This is a testing time for us all. Please remember that by staying safe we are protecting our own and everyone's family.
