Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

I would just like to start by thanking our wonderful community for your continued support throughout this term. As a school and community, we have faced many new challenges together. What do I do if my child displays symptoms/tests positive during the Christmas break?

If a child or member of staff starts with symptoms after school closes today up to midnight on Sunday 20th December we must ask that you email the Covid-19 email address covidresultRSJB@smat.org.uk. As soon as you receive the results, please email a copy, whether positive or negative, to the above email address. If the test is negative nothing further will be done. If the test is positive, school will contact all other people from the bubble by text informing them of their need to isolate.

If a child begins with symptoms from Monday 21st onwards this will not impact upon the school bubbles **as their classmates and staff will not need to isolate**, but please inform us and forward the details of the positive test as it may impact your child/ren's return to school in January.

Please remember upon return if anyone in the household is going for a Covid test due to symptoms then the whole household **must** isolate; pupils **must not** return to school until there is a negative test result even if the symptoms are no longer apparent. This is **vital** to keep us all safe. Thank you to all parents that have used the email to report results to us and helped us close bubbles swiftly. Please take extra care over Christmas so we can all join back together on 4th January when school returns.

Hope you have a wonderful and safe Christmas. We look forward to welcoming you all back on 4th January and we cannot wait to see our Year Six children again.
