Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

We hope that the children have enjoyed their first two weeks back at school. We have a very busy term ahead of us which we hope will not be interrupted by any positive cases of COVID. We are all aware that restrictions are beginning to ease throughout the country, but at present the guidance for schools still remains the same as it was in September. Our bubbles will remain in place until we are told differently, all of the extra cleaning and safety protocols for the children in school will continue and we also ask you to continue wearing a face covering in the school grounds. Hopefully before we break for summer this protocol can be changed.

Music Lessons

Our music teachers from Barnsley Music Services are now looking for some new recruits. If your child is interested in taking up guitar, cello or violin lessons and are in Year 3,4 or 5 please contact school and we will begin to make the arrangements. Woodwind lessons are also now available for Year 3 and 4. These sessions will be in school time.

Please remember to maintain a social distance of 2 metres and wear a face covering, unless you are exempt, outside of school when queuing on Vicarage Lane to drop off and pick up your children. This is not only vital for supporting us as a school but also for supporting our local community in Royston. Please can we also just remind parents that if anyone in the household has symptoms then the whole family **must** isolate. If anyone in the household is going for a Covid test due to symptoms then the whole household **must** isolate; pupils **must not** return to school until there is a negative test result even if the symptoms are no longer apparent. Here is our school procedure for reporting test results:

- Between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Mon to Fri (term time) ring the school office on **01226 722011**
- Out of school hours – evenings and weekends we ask that you email the test result through to our new email address covidresultRSJB@smat.org.uk. This will be monitored periodically on an evening and at the weekend. **Please do not use our normal email addresses to report test results.**
- Thank you for your ongoing support and help.

Please also remember that pupils can choose if they would like a school lunch on a day- by day basis. If children are bringing a packed lunch please make healthy choices. We are looking at working with families over the summer term to support parents in working with school to make healthy choices for your children.

The outdoor area next to Year 1 and Reception Class is not for playing in at the end of the school day. Mrs Openshaw and the early years team have worked so hard to create a wonderful outdoor space for the younger children to use as part of their curriculum and it is being damaged by children at home time. Please supervise children closely on collection to ensure that pupils are safe and our outdoor area is kept safe too.
