Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

Following Monday night's announcement by the Prime Minister we have had to make some changes to our plans for the Summer Term. The extension of restrictions takes us up to the second to last week therefore what I can confirm now is that we will run our bubble system until the end of term. It also means that we will not be able to have parents/carers there for Sports Day. We will have Sports Day but this will be in bubbles (dates to follow).

Year 6

The Year 6 children are preparing a Leaver's Assembly and we are hoping parents will be able to come to the school grounds on the very last day of term to watch this (23.7.21). This will be dependent on further relaxation of Covid regulations. Due to the change in guidance, it does however mean that our Year 6 production will now be streamed live. The date of this will be July 8th at 6:00pm for Year 6 families. This will be streamed using Google Classroom. Our Year 6 children have put so much effort into this, we know you will love it! It is vital that all year 6 children stay and take part for the production to be a success. We will keep children in school and give them their tea on this night (more details will follow). Pupils in school will get the opportunity to watch the production earlier the same day in classrooms too. Our residential trip to Robinwood **WILL** go ahead too! We also have plans for a Water Sports Day in school as well with Miss Bailey and Mr Hague.

Unfortunately, due to the change in guidance there will be no transition days this side of the academic year for Secondary School. Outwood Academy will visit the pupils next Friday 25th June and Holy Trinity, Monday 28 June. Both of these visits will be in school. At Kettlethorpe on Wednesday 8th September, the new Y7 will be in school for their first day of timetabled lessons along with Y11 as a staggered approach. This will help us to understand where our pupils are and help you as parents to understand if your child is meeting age expected standards in reading.
