Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

This week we saw our wonderful Reception and Year 6 children take part in a traditional Nativity in Church. Thank you to all the parents and carers who attended. We were so proud of the children and the singing sounded beautiful from our older pupils. We usually include the whole school in Church to support with singing, but the Year 6 pupils really did hold their own.

Thank you to parents for being flexible and understanding with concert dates. A handful of parents contacted us to say they could not attend the session allocated to their child's year group which we have accommodated on the original date we set. Limiting interactions and further reducing numbers in the hall was the only way for us to move forward with the concerts. We will put a recorded version of the Year 1 and 2 Nativity and the year 3, 4 and 5 Carol Concert on the website for all families to enjoy at home by Friday. The Reception and Year 6 Nativity is on Twitter recorded in full.

**As part of attending the concerts in school, we ask that all adults attending do a lateral flow test prior to coming into school and all adults MUST wear a face mask too. This is to help protect others. If you have a medical reason whereby you cannot wear a mask, please speak to Ms Steele on the gate prior to attending or ring the school office. We have a duty of care to protect our pupils and we may refuse entry. As I said last week, many other schools in Barnsley have cancelled audiences attending and this is not what we wanted. Masks are part of our risk assessment and the only way we can move forward with the shows.**

I thank you in advance and I know that our wonderful community will come together for the children.

We also wanted to let you know that the crossing patrol, Mrs Linford, will be absent after an operation from the 13<sup>th</sup> for 6 weeks. This may affect the route Year 5 and 6 pupils want to take to school.
