Dear Mums, Dads, and Carers,

It's been lovely to welcome all our children and families back after the summer break. #### **Reminders**

**School Timings** - School arrivals are now between 8:45am-8.55am. Arriving after 8.55am will result in a late mark for that day. If you are late to school children should report to the main school office. Collection time will be 3:30pm as it was last year. Gates will be open from 3:25pm and children will leave school at 3:30pm. We will still operate our one-way system for drop offs and pickups too as this has worked really well. When collecting your child, please ensure your child is well supervised. Outdoor equipment is not to be played or climbed on whilst exiting the school grounds at the end of the school day.

**Illness** - Please do not send your child to school before **48 hours** from their last bout of diarrhoea or sickness as this illness can be easily passed onto other children. On leaving a voicemail on our absence line, please ensure you state your child's symptoms and not 'unwell' as a reason for their absence.

**Earrings** – Please can all earrings be removed for PE. Children will miss this lesson if they have them in and cannot remove them by themselves.

**Polite Request** – We politely request that when dropping children off and picking them up from school that parents do not walk on the path in front of the classroom windows but remain on the playground. This eases the congestion outside the classroom and ensures that we can better supervise children to ensure that they make their way into the classroom or to you safely.

**Safeguarding** - We would also like to remind parents and carers that the minimum age for someone to collect a child from school is 14. If anyone under the age of 14 comes to collect your child, we will unfortunately have to refuse their request and keep the child in school until they are collected by an adult.

**Parent Pay** – Over the summer there has been an update to parent pay and the way that lunches are selected. This update now means that, if you so wish, you have the option to pre-order your child's lunches at home by logging into parent pay. We would like to stress that children will still have the opportunity to select their lunches in school each day as well.

JOIN WAKEFIELD CATHEDRAL CHOIR- As some of our children will remember we had the privilege to welcome Ed Jones from Wakefield Cathedral earlier this year. He has asked if I would let you all know that next week on Tuesday and Wednesday, they are holding open rehearsals at the cathedral and a 'be a chorister' trial day which may be of interest.
