

St Marys C of E School Uniform Policy

At Royston St John Baptist we pride ourselves on our professional presentation. School uniform plays a valuable part in contributing to the ethos of the school and setting appropriate tone. Our Uniform Policy is to be adhered to by all pupils.

General: White shirt/blouse Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore dress/shorts Green jumper/cardigan Green and white checked dress Plain white, grey or black socks/plain tights Black plain flat shoes/ankle boots School tie Hair clips, slides, headbands must be discrete and in school colours

P.E: White polo shirt/plain white T-shirt Black shorts Black jogging bottoms Black sweatshirt Black pumps/trainers Hair must be tied back and jewellery removed

NOTE:

Your child must be able to remove jewellery themselves or must be removed at home on the day of PE in line with Health & Safety guidance. Staff will not be responsible for removing earrings.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

The following items are NOT considered appropriate school wear:

- · High heels, platform soled shoes
 - Trainers
 - · Hooded garments
 - · Hoop or pendant earrings
 - Nail warnish
 - Make up
 - Tattoo transfers
 - Hair colour/glitter
- · Jewellery and fashion accessories

Reception class children are given a school book bag when they start. Uniform for all pupils including ties or book bags with the school logo on can be ordered at the School Office via Vortex.
