Dear Mums, Dads, and Carers,

It was amazing to see so many of our wonderful families in church yesterday for our Easter Mass with Father Craig. The children were amazing, and I feel that it's important that we share the remarkable story of Easter with you all. I would like to thank you all for your continued support with these events and we look forward to inviting you to many more of our celebrations at church and in school in the future.

As part of our continued development of the school, we have created a home – school agreement, which will be coming home with the children tonight. The aim of this agreement is to ensure that as parents and carers there is clarity around what we expect from yourselves and the children, and equally importantly, around what you can expect from us as a school. During the Easter Holidays, the school website will be updated with a new behaviour policy and behaviour curriculum.

After Easter, the PE days for some of the classes have changed so please check the new days for your child or children.

I hope you all have a brilliant and relaxing Easter Holiday, and we look forward to welcoming the children back into school for the start of our Summer Term on Monday 17th April.

Medical Information

Medicines and laxatives must be handed in at the office so a medicine form can be completed and staff made aware of any child needing medicines in their class. It is important that these are not left with the children, either in water bottles or in their bags, as other children in the class may accidentally have access to these. If your child is suffering from diarrhea and/or sickness, please remember it is 48 hours from their last bout before they should come back into school. This minimises the risk of spreading this contagious illness to other children.

Lates

If your child enters school through the main office entrance after 8.55 then a late mark will be incurred on the register. If your child enters through the exit gate, then again a late mark will be incurred.

Absences

Please ensure you call school on each day of your child's absence, unless advised otherwise, either by speaking to a member of staff or leaving a message on the absence line. Failure to inform school of your child's absence will result in an unauthorised absence mark on the register. Ten or more of these marks can result in a council fine. Evidence is needed for any medical appointments taken during the school day. Please remember that if your child is absent with sickness and/or diarrhoea they must not return to school till 48 hours after their last bout. This helps in preventing the illness being passed on to other children.
