Dear Mums, Dads, and Carers,

It's been great to welcome you all back for the final term of the year. I really do hope you all had a wonderfully relaxing Easter break. This term is one of the busiest in the school, with lots happening and lots to prepare for. In a few weeks, Year 6 will be taking their SATs assessments followed by children in Year 2 the week after. Year 4 will also be completing their formal multiplication assessment in the summer term too.

There are a few changes to our lunch time, happening from Monday. In order to encourage children to eat more, and make the dining hall a calmer, more inviting environment, we are trialling having the children eat in sittings. For this, the children will be taken into the hall by an adult in school, where they will have their dinner and then have the opportunity to socialise with their peers over a twenty minute period. At the end of this period, the children will be taken outside where they can enjoy the rest of the playtime outdoors. Our Foundation Stage and Year 1 will have their dinner between 11: 45 and 12:05, Year 2, 3 and 6 will have their dinner between 12:05 and 12:25 and Years 4 & 5 will have their dinners between 12:25 and 12:45. These times ensure that the children will not be having their dinner any later than what is already the case.

There are a number of trips happening later in the summer term as well and these will be appearing on Parent Pay and letters coming home to you about these in the near future.

Also, we have parents' meetings next Wednesday for Year 1 to 5, with Foundation Stage parents meeting with the teacher the week after on the 3<sup>rd</sup> May. I look forward to seeing as many of you in school to discuss your child(ren)'s progress as possible.

If you have any questions regarding anything in school, please speak to us and we will be happy to help in any way we can.

#### **Polite Reminders**

<u>Staff Car Park</u> – Could I please request that parents and carers do not use the staff car park when picking up or dropping off children at the end of the school day. We have a number of staff who often need to leave school to attend meetings at other venues.

<u>Attendance</u> – It is vital that children attending school arrive on time at the start of the day. The school day starts at 8:55 when the register is closed and lessons begin promptly at that time. If your child is regularly late, they are missing vital learning time, and often learning time of the same lesson each time. This has a major impact on the children's education and progress and can often leave the child who arrives late unsettled for the start of the school day.
