Dear Mums, Dads, and Carers,

Firstly, I would like to apologise for the delay in getting the newsletter out (printing issues). As we approach the end of the school year, we are preparing for the next academic year, and as such the children have completed their transition into their next class in school this morning. The teachers, support staff and children have had a fantastic day filled with great activities that gives everyone the chance to get to know each other. These days are so important in ensuring everyone is as prepared as possible to hit the ground running when returning to school in September.

This week is once again filled with activity. Firstly, on Monday, we are holding our KS1 film night in the school hall after school. This will be followed by the KS2 film night on Tuesday. Tuesday will also see Year 3 holding their Roman Activity Day which will be a fantastic way to end their topic about the Roman invasion of Britain. Parentpay Lunch debt – Please can any parents owing money on Parentpay for their child's lunch ensure this is paid and up to date by the end of the school term (Thursday 27th July) as requested by the SMAT finance department. If money is owing on Wednesday 26th July, a school lunch will not be provided on Thursday, the last day of term. This is especially important for year 6 as they will not be returning to school in September.
