Nasal Spray Flu Vaccination

Reminders

School Timings - School arrivals are now between 8:45am-8.55am. Arriving after 8.55am will result in a late mark for that day. Gates will be open from 3:25pm and children will leave school at 3:30pm. We will still operate our one-way system for drop offs and pickups too as this has worked really well. When collecting your child, please ensure your child is well supervised. Outdoor equipment is not to be played or climbed on whilst exiting the school grounds at the end of the school day.

Illness - Please do not send your child to school before **48 hours** from their last bout of diarrhoea or sickness as this illness can be easily passed onto other children. On leaving a voicemail on our absence line, please ensure you state your child's symptoms and not 'unwell' as a reason for their absence.

Earrings – Please can all earrings be removed for PE. Children will miss this lesson if they have them in and cannot remove them by themselves.

Water Bottles – Please could you ensure that children are sent with a water bottle to school, and that these only contain water and not dilute, fruit juice or any other kind of soft drink.

Staff Car Park - Please can parents refrain from parking in the school staff car park at drop off and pick up times. The car park is for staff and any visitors to school only. The car park can be locked at any time during the school day, so unfortunately any car not belonging to a staff member or visitor could get locked in. Thank you in advance for your co-operation. Also please be considerate and ensure that you do not block any residents drives when parking.
